Applicant Eligibility Criteria

- Have a minimum 3.25 GPA.
- Be enrolled in an accredited college or university in Arizona.
- Be pursuing a degree in a museum program or a history discipline with an emphasis on women.
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 12 hours per semester.
- Be an United States citizen, DACA or re-entry student.

Award Details

- The scholarship is a one-time award of \$1,000.00 sent to the educational institution for tuition and fees.
- The scholarship is not renewable; however, applicants may reapply each year.
- Selection will be based on the merits of applicant.

- Winner will be notified by December 18, 2026.
